participants screened!

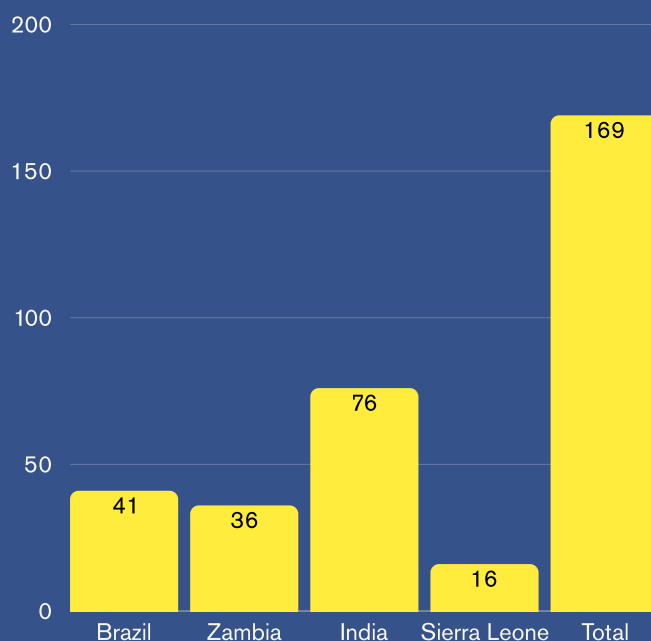
We finished November with **169** new

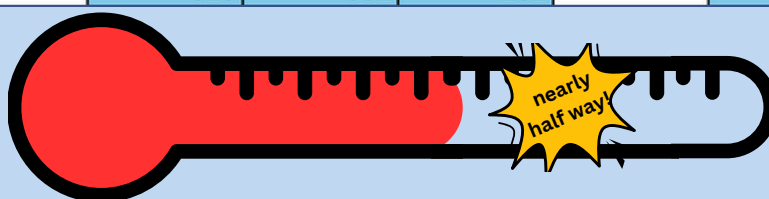

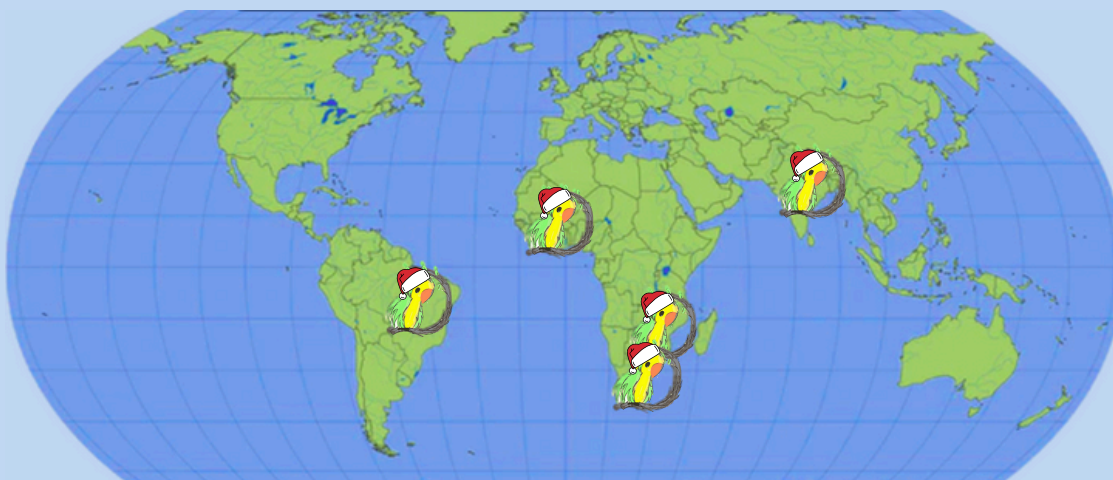
