participants **screened**!

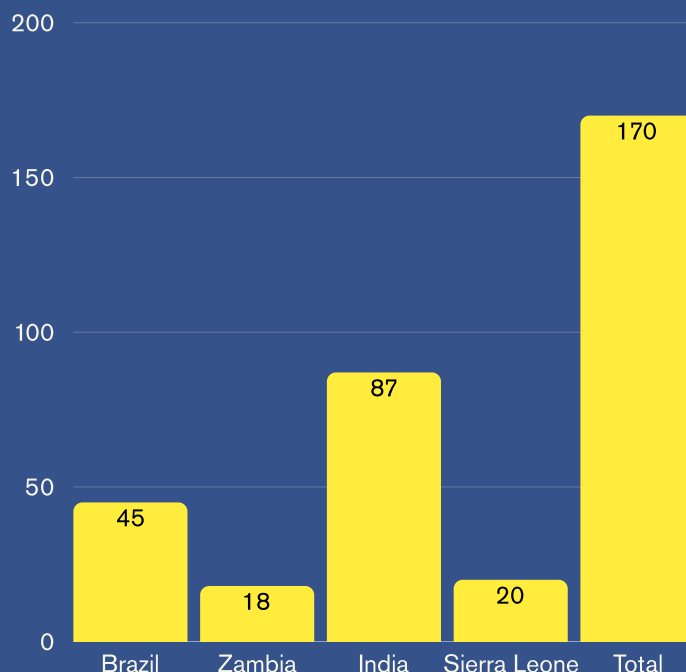
We finished January with **170** new

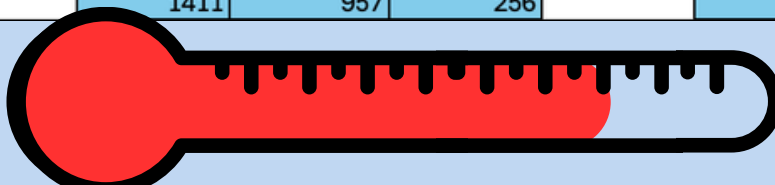

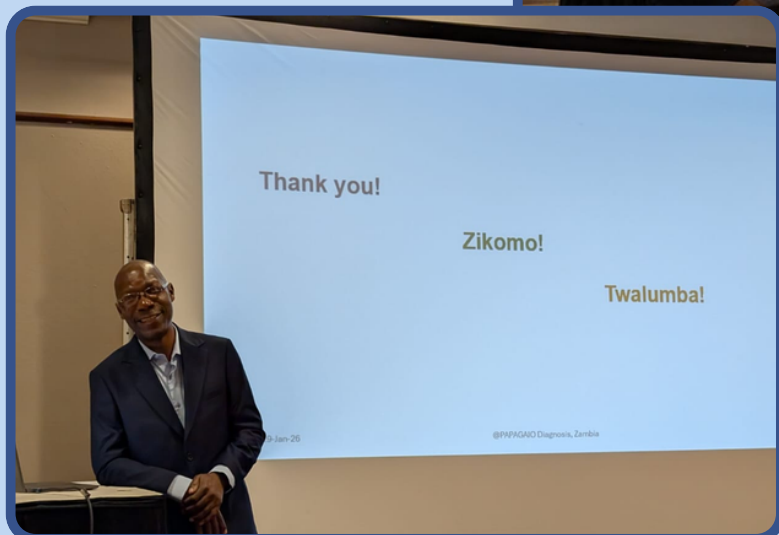
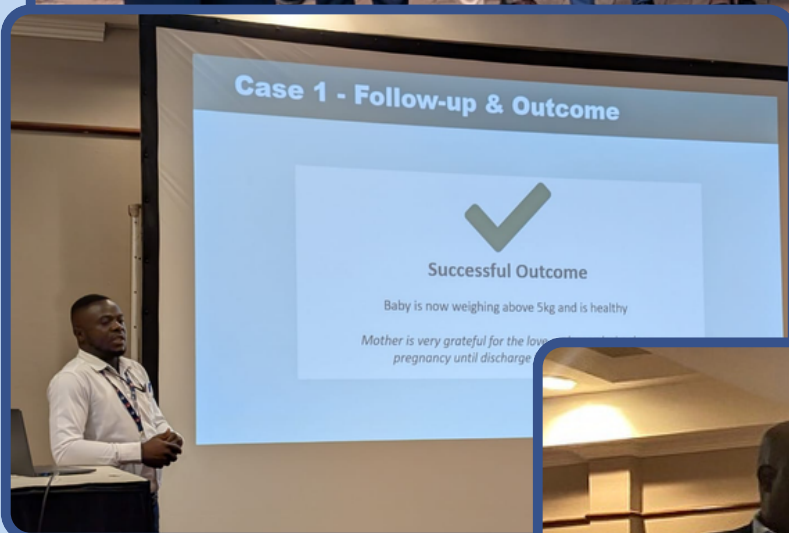

PIGF Result Reminder

A **low (<12)** or **abnormal (12-99) PIGF** result is **not** an automatic indication for delivery.

A **PIGF <12 pg/ml confirms a diagnosis** of pre-eclampsia, but does not necessarily indicate severity! Some women can remain pregnant for several weeks, with close surveillance according to local guidelines.

Clinical teams should use their clinical judgement to time delivery.

Low PIGF alone is not a severe feature.
